

Awards for All

INTRODUCTION

The National Lottery's small grants scheme, Awards for All, gives grants for people to take part in art, sport and community activities, and projects that promote education, the environment and health in the local community. Awards for All is a joint awards programme set up to help small groups whose income is less than £20,000 per annum and involves three Lottery distributors: the Big Lottery Fund, the Scottish Arts Council and sportscotland.

Key Facts

Grants of between £500 and £10,000

Aimed at small groups and projects whose income is less than £20,000 per annum.

No deadline for applications

The programme funds a wide range of activities and support projects that meet the following outcomes:

1. People have better chances in life.
2. Communities are safer, stronger and more able to work together to tackle inequalities.
3. People have better and more sustainable services and environments.
4. People and communities are healthier.

FUNDS AVAILABLE

Grants of between £500 and £10,000 available.

WHO CAN APPLY

Eligible applicants should be a not-for-profit / voluntary and community sector group, community council, statutory body or school.

WHAT CAN BE FUNDED

Some examples of what the grant can pay for are:

- equipment hire or purchase,
- feasibility studies for community building projects,
- improvements or additions to playing facilities,
- IT equipment,
- publicity materials,
- sessional workers,
- start up costs,
- team clothing or kit
